

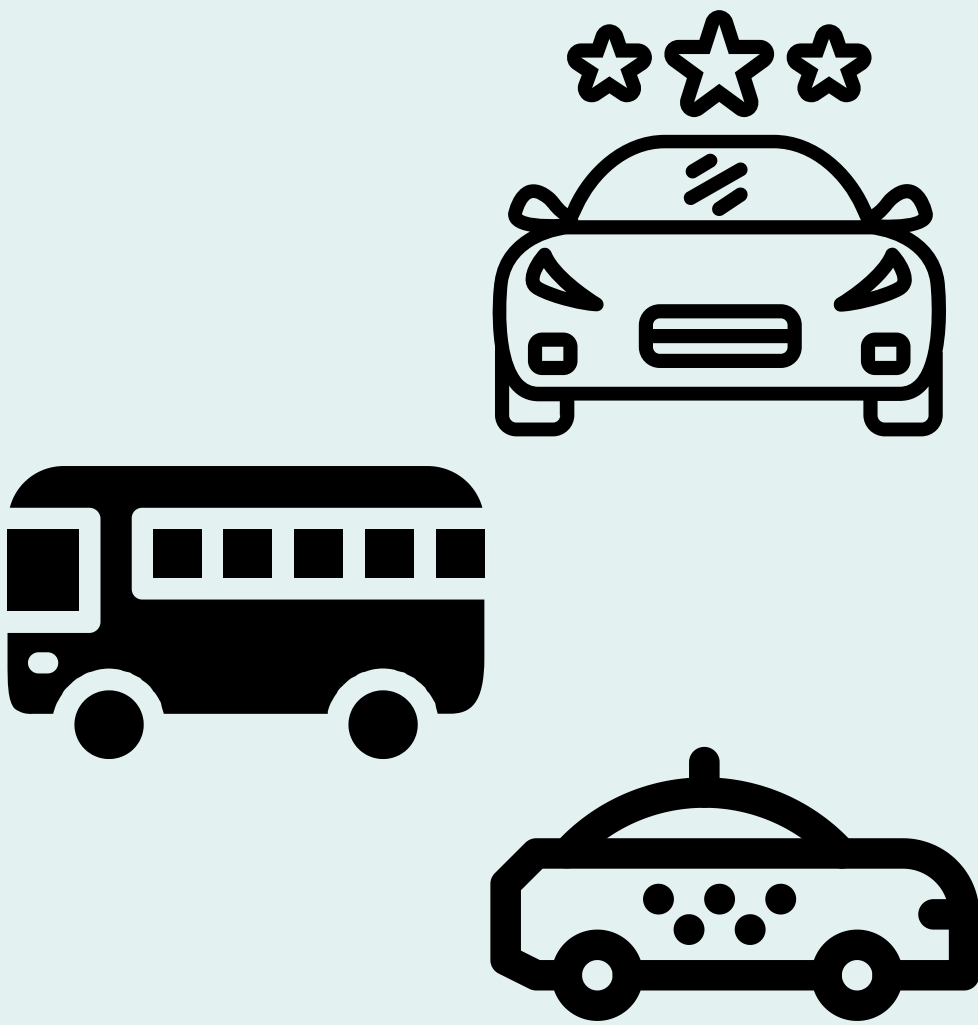

- Air Conditioner



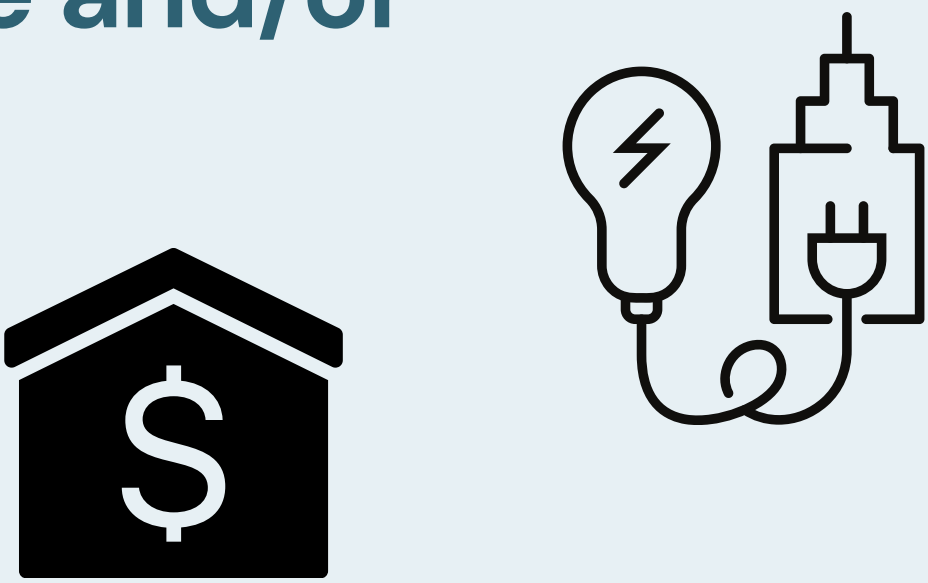
Assistance with Security Deposit

- Security Deposit to obtain safe/affordable housing



Financial assistance to prevent eviction/foreclosure and/or utility shut off

- Rent or mortgage payment
- Utility payment



Food and personal care assistance

- Five-day supply of food
- Assistance with special dietary needs
- Personal care items (shampoo, soap, tooth brush/tooth paste, etc.)



Emergency Expenses

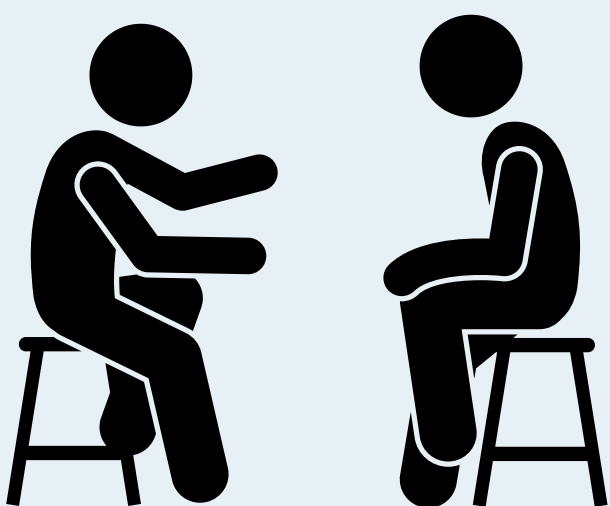
Examples (not limited to this list):

- Car insurance
